





WEST SIDE STORY - THE STORY

Moving the Capulet and Montague families from Verona where Shakespeare had_set them in his "Romeo & Juliet" to New York and naming them Jets and Sharks was an inspired idea. The setting is the crowded tenements of that city and the rivalry is between the natives and incoming Puerto Ricans. Leonard Bernstein's score and Stephen Sondheim's lyrics combined to produce a breathtaking show and the subsequent film, which in 1961 won an impressive eleven Oscars. Incidentally four out of the last five shows CO2 have presented have been set in New York – truly a city that never sleeps.


